The mission to Kakamega, Kenya almost didn't come off due to a cancellation of flights as a result of the volcanic eruption in Iceland, which sent a huge cloud of ashes over Europe. But by the grace of God Benedicta and I were able to rebook on the very first flight Delta had through Amsterdam after the air cleared.

We had to hit the ground running; there was no time for adjusting ourselves to the time change or recovering from jet lag. We arrived at the ministry site on Friday morning, and by the afternoon I was teaching and ministering on the life of Joshua. That evening I preached at the outdoor crusade on "Who is this Jesus."

Our time flew by as conference teachings followed crusade preaching. The Lord was faithful and answered my prayer for "no dry meetings." The Holy Spirit's presence was rich and abundant. We saw a goodly number of people responding to the gospel invitations, and pastors and believers were encouraged by the conference teachings.

We were able to deliver a set of Christian books to the Kenya team to take to Kumi, Uganda, for the second year students. Before we knew it, we were on our way back home, enduring those uncomfortable airplane seats and trying to sleep a little here and there. We arrived home tired but grateful for another mission accomplished, and for the privilege of watching the Holy Spirit work among His precious African people.
